“Based on the feedback we’ve had from our participants, it’s been extremely valuable (Locelle’s mentorship program). Firstly, in allowing our team members to connect with people in a time where people seemed disconnected, offering that connection and time to meet with someone to discuss whatever topic they require, like: career development, professional development and personal development has been extremely valuable. ”

In order to have a successful organization or team, you need input from a lot of different backgrounds and a lot of different voices in order to succeed. So having a diverse pipeline and a diverse team especially with women from a majority of different backgrounds, and women in higher level technical positions as well, adds to that enriched experience and it ensures that a team can move forward successfully.”
