VanHack opened in 2014 as an online school and recruitment platform, but soon pivoted to become a marketplace for employers looking for international tech talent. Actively Advocating for Women in the Workplace

Dedicated to making a difference, VanHack is going against the stats. Male-dominated tech is known to be especially lacking within the areas of <u>hiring women for executive</u> <u>leadership roles, at a rate of 24%</u>-yet VanHack's leadership team is 50% women.
